<u>Director's Report — Library Operation and COVID-19</u>

- 1. Winnefox and Oshkosh libraries are closed tentative to April 6 stopping deliveries, holds, etc., making doing business difficult. Digital libraries are unaffected.
 - 2. Twelve other libraries in system closed and another 12 meeting to discuss closures.
- 3. The virus appears to live up to 3 days on plastics, etc.; there are not enough disinfectants/wipes, etc., to handle current daily volume.
 - a. Consideration needs to be given to how to address handling of returned books and the book drop.
- 4. One option is to close to public and employees would continue to work and be available to monitor phones and be available to answer reference questions, etc.
 - a. Staff could do special projects as required to fill hours.
